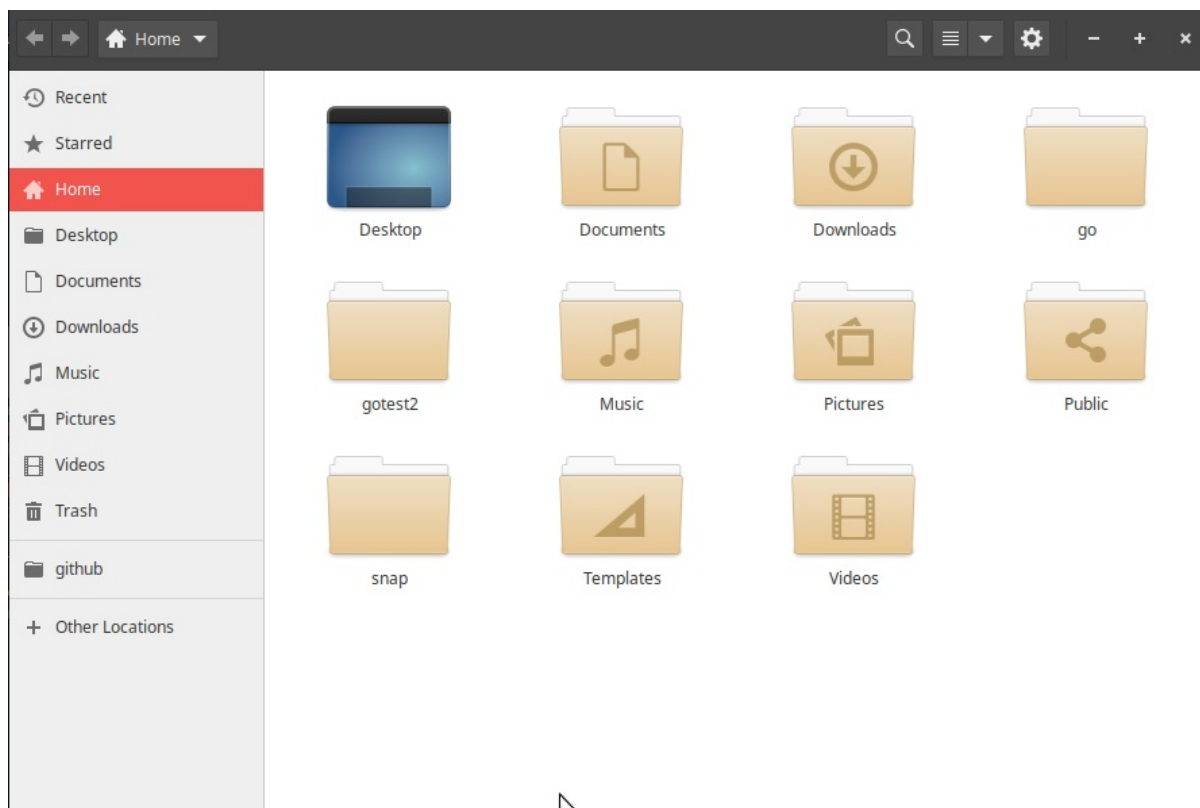
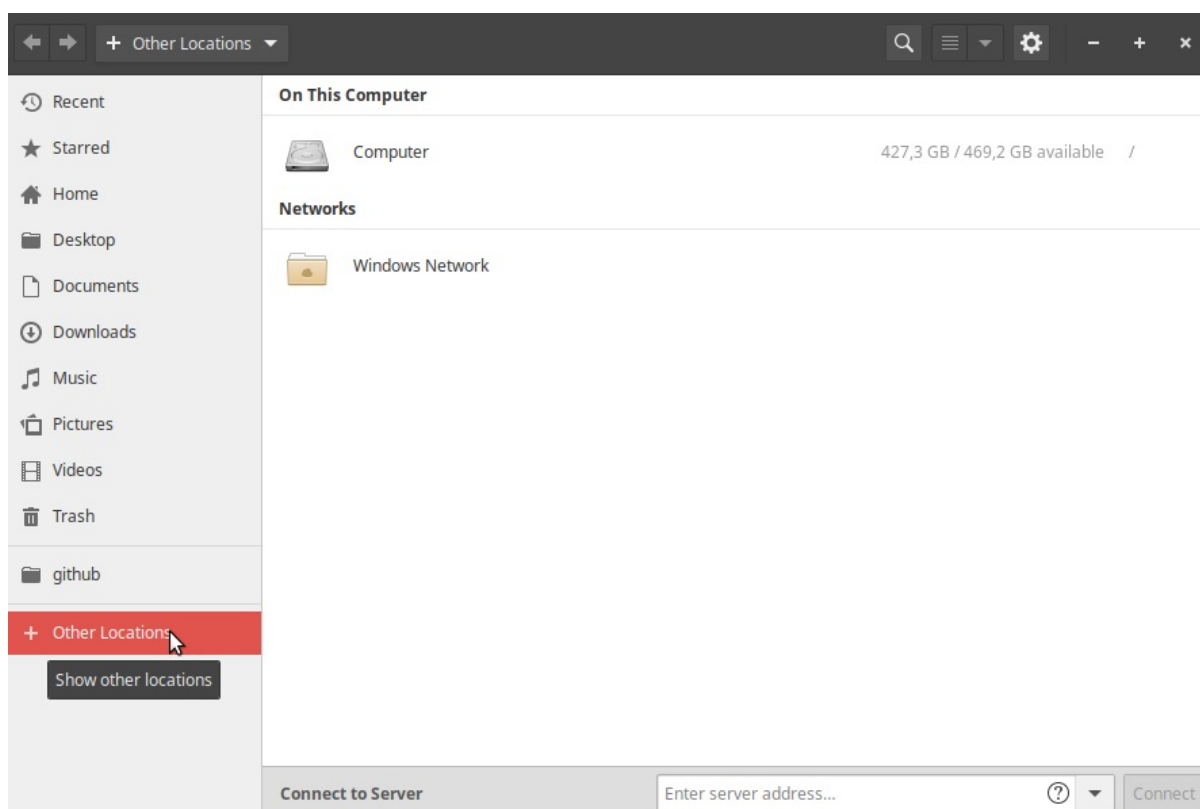


How to set up an FTP client in Linux Ubuntu?

In order to configure an FTP client in Linux Ubuntu, you first need to open the file manager **Nautilus**



From there, select the **Other locations**(network location) folder in the left column,



Choose a list of available local networks, or go directly by typing **address** of the device

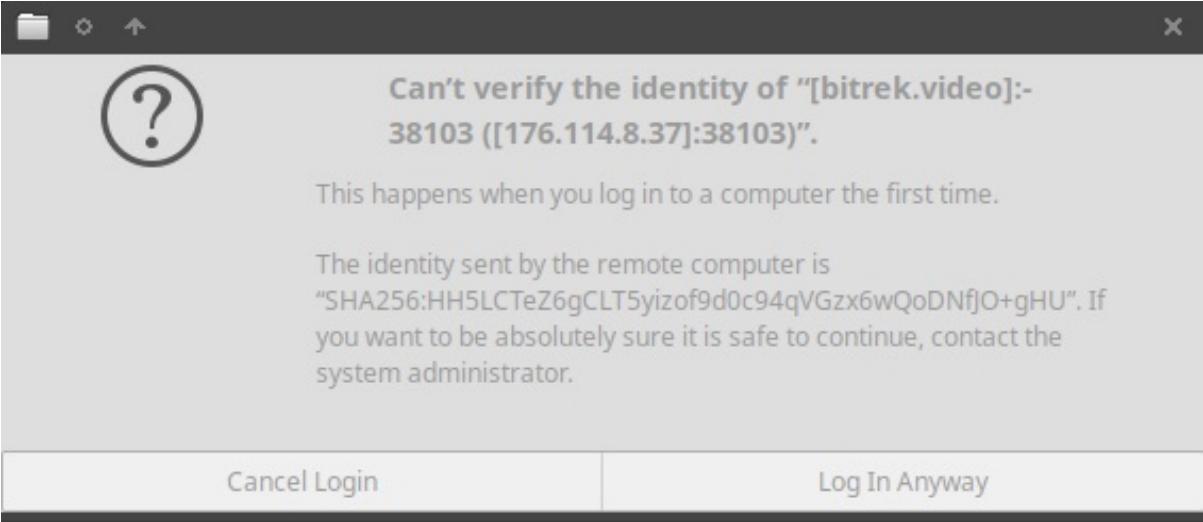
Connect to Server

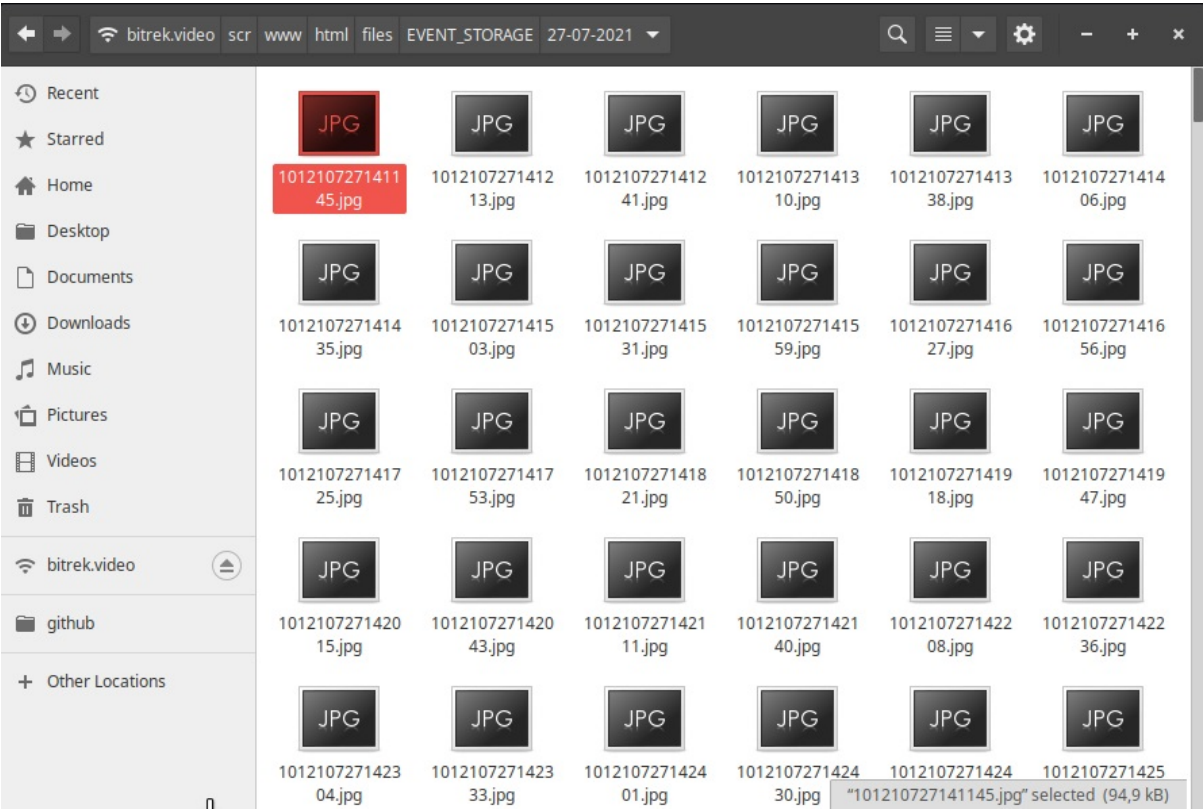
After that, confirm **login**



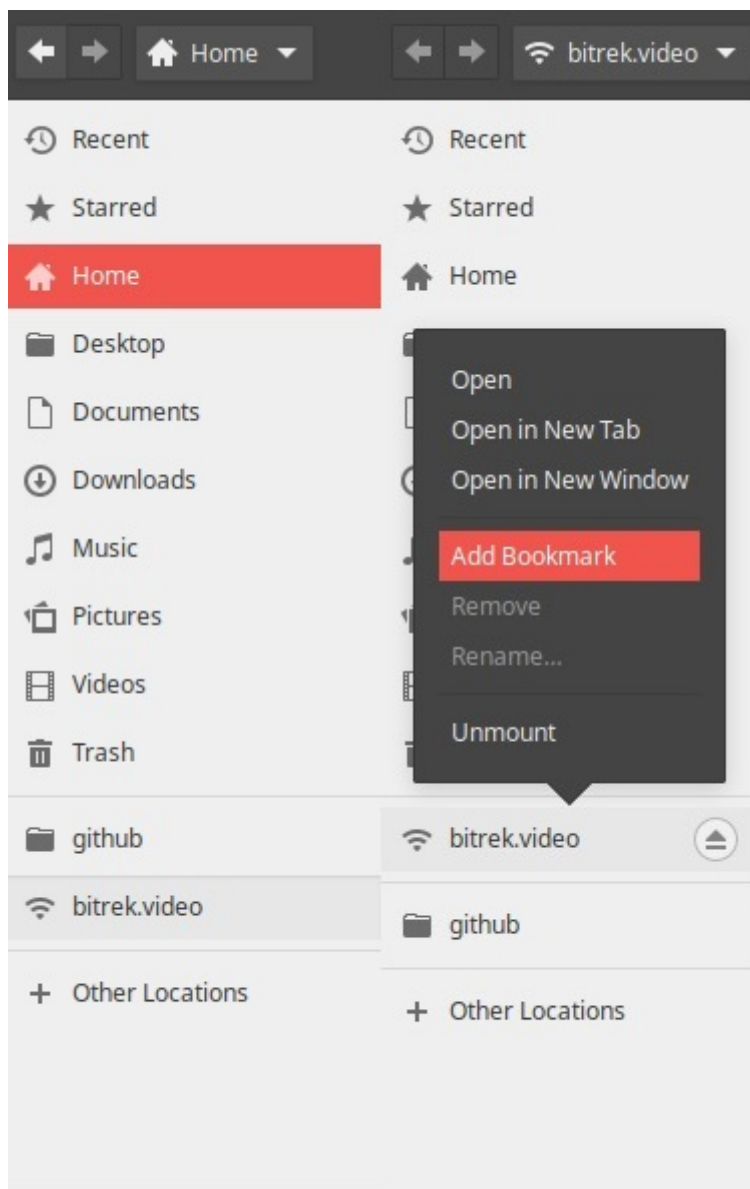
Enter **login** and **password**



Done! you're in the FTP device, you can view your files, photos and videos



For convenience, so you don't have to constantly enter your device address, you can add it to a bookmark for quick access by right-clicking on the network in the file manager side menu and adding it to your bookmarks
